This will be an online tournament taking place over Zoom (debate and extemp) and using Google (for recorded speech events) to raise money for relief and research efforts to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

CHARITY INFORMATION:

Proceeds from the registration fees from this tournament will go towards to the Center for Disease Control (CDC) Emergency Response Fund. This charity helps countries across the globe respond to pandemics with capital to fund immediate needs of citizens but also fueling the research that will bring about a permanent solution to this global crisis.

"Funds raised by the CDC Foundation through our Emergency Response Fund will be used to meet fast-emerging needs identified by CDC to help respond to the public health threat posed by this virus. These include additional support for state and local health departments, support for the global response, logistics, communications, data management, personal protective equipment, critical response supplies and more."

*Note: Anyone who is participating in a recording-based speech event may also enter in extemporaneous or any debate event. There is no limit to the number of recorded speech events that you may enter. Please enter judges and make donations according to the total number of entries that you have.

RULES:

This tournament will use the rules for the upcoming NSDA National Tournament.

For debate events:

- Preparation time for Policy Debate will be 8 minutes.
- Preparation Times for LD and PF will be increased by one minute.
 - PF specific: The judge must flip a coin at the beginning of the round in order to determine sides and speaking order
- Evidence sharing must be done through a virtual chat room (such as through Zoom) or an email chain
- For Worlds Schools, points of information (POI) will be done through a wave of a participant's hand or the hand raise icon on Zoom. **There will be no verbal interruptions.**

For speech events:

- For pre-recorded events, all registrants must put the URL's to their videos in the section on Tabroom that denotes "speech title/selection" and on the section marked "online info. This is in order to ensure that judges can easily access speeches on their ballots. Make sure to make YouTube videos "Unlisted" and not "Private."
 - o These URLs must be sent to the tournament coordinators by Friday, May 29 at 8:00 AM.

The registration fee is \$10.00* per student. Please make all checks payable to North Allegheny Senior High School (or NASH). Please indicate in the subject line that payment is for the Pennsylvania Online Charity Tournament.

*Note: For teams competing in Worlds Schools, the fee will be \$20.00 per team.

JUDGE REQUIREMENTS

1 judge per 4 speech entries; 1 judge per 2 debate entries (one two-person team=one debate entry). ALL BALLOTING WILL BE DONE ONLINE. Please be sure that your judges are registered on TABROOM and linked to your school. **Seniors are allowed to judge or compete.**

We will be awarding certificates to the top competitors in each event. These will be emailed to coaches following the tournament.
