Important Deadlines

- November 13, 2020 Waitlist Cleared
 - Each program is initially limited to 4 entries per division, with additional entries waitlisted; after this deadline, waitlisted entries will be admitted in order of precedence, regardless of program affiliation
- November 20, 2020 Fees Frozen + Entry Names, Required Forms, Hired Judging Requests Due
 - Drops after this deadline will still owe associated entry fees
 - TBA entries will be replaced by those with names attached
 - o Programs with any missing forms will have their entries moved to the waitlist
 - Hired judging requests will no longer be accepted
- November 27, 2020 Payment Due + Registration Closed
 - Programs who have not remitted payment, or confirmed its on the way, will have their entries moved to the waitlist
 - New entries will no longer be accepted on Tabroom; please contact <u>nyfallfaceoff@gmail.com</u> to request additions after this deadline

- November 30, 2020 Judging Due
 - Programs who have not entered judge names on Tabroom, or whose hire requests have not been accepted, will have their entries moved to the waitlist
