Eligibility:

All students who are sanctioned by their principals to complete as a member of their school may compete at the Bear Cat Swing.

Novice: Students in their first year of high school debate are eligible to compete in the Novice division. All entries must be sanctioned by their school and have supervision by a chaperone who is an employee of the school. Parents or other adults associated with students participating in the tournament do not satisfy this requirement.

Congress - .25 rounds owed per entry. 1 judge can cover 4 rounds/\$25/missing round (12 entries/1 judge)

NLD/NPF - .5 rounds owed per entry. 1 judge can cover 6 rounds/\$15/missing round (12 entries/1 judge)

NCX – 1 round owed per entry. 1 judge can cover 4 rounds/\$15/missing round (4 entries/1 judge)
