Registration

- All registration will be online at www.tabroom.com
- Registration is open to all 9th-12th grade representing the schools they attend.
- No independent student entries will be accepted.
- Registration will open on Sept. 30th at 7 am.
- Deadline for adds is Oct. 16th at 9 pm.
- Recorded IE deadline is Oct. 19th at 4 pm.**
- Deadline for drops (without fees) is Oct. 19th at 4 pm.

Events

- IE's include: Humorous, Dramatic, Duo, Poetry, Prose, Impromptu, Extemp, Inform, Oratory, ADS, POI, Storytelling, LIELL, and Radio.
- Novice and Senior divisions will be offered if enough students register for all events except Storytelling, LIELL, HI, DI, Duo, POI, and Extemp. These events will be open division only.
- Debate includes: Congress, Lincoln-Douglas, Public Forum, Policy, and Parli.

IMPORTANT

- We will use the novice resolution for novice LD.
- Teams must have an adult available throughout the tournament. A reachable phone number must be provided during registration.
- DUO and Partnered Debates:** Students must follow the guidance of their schools and legal guardians when competing in these events. Judges will be instructed to honor the decisions of the schools/legal guardians and not judge based on proximity.
- We will have hangout rooms online for each team.

Judges

- All judges must be registered through Tabroom. Judges may sign up for both live and recorded events.
- Recorded events- Judges should register as an asynchronous judge. These judges will be assigned preliminary rounds on Oct. 19th by 8 pm. Preliminary round ballots will be due on Oct. 22nd by 4 pm. Final rounds will be assigned on Oct. 22nd by 8 pm. Final round ballots will be due on Oct. 23rd at 11:59 pm.
- Live events- Judges should register as synchronous judges for days available.
- Judging fees- This year, schools will be responsible for providing an adequate number of judges. Teams not meeting the minimum requirement will be charged.

- Schools should make sure their judges have had preliminary judges training or explanation of judging requirements. Click [here](#) for some NSDA resources for judges.
