Impromptu and Extemp are Live. Students will speak in the order they are listed on Tabroom. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus. WE WILL ALLOW DOUBLE ENTRY IN LIVE EVENTS, BUT IT'S WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THEY WILL NOT RECEIVE A REFUND FOR MISSING ROUNDS.

Debate is live. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus

Other IEs are recorded. These will be listed as 'link sharing only' on youtube and links will be posted on specific entries. These are due on October 26th at 4pm. THE PASSWORD THAT MUST BE HELD UP AT THE START OF EACH VIDEO IS "ACTAA QUIRKY TURKEY" IF A PASSWORD ISN'T HELD UP, THE ENTRY WILL BE DROPPED AND HAVE A \$25 FINE.

IE piece information needs to be uploaded to Tabroom by October 26th at 4pm. Failure to upload piece information will result in an inability to compete with no refund.
