Resolutions:

- Lincoln Douglas: Resolved: The United States ought to provide a federal jobs guarantee.
- **Public Forum**: Resolved: The United States should adopt a declaratory nuclear policy of no first use.
- Policy: Resolved: The United States federal government should enact substantial criminal justice reform in the United States in one or more of the following: forensic science, policing, sentencing.
- Novice Policy Case Areas:
 - 1) Forensic Science: Limit use of facial recognition software.
 - **2) Policing**: Abandon federal efforts to force local police to assist in immigration enforcement.
 - 3) Sentencing: Abolish mandatory minimum sentences.
 - 4) Sentencing: Drug decriminalization
