# The 17<sup>th</sup> Scarvite November 14<sup>th</sup> (Sat) - 15<sup>th</sup> (Sun)

We are pleased to announce the 17<sup>th</sup> edition of the Scarsdale Invitational debate tournament.

#### The Basics

The tournament will be at held virtually on NSDA Campus from Saturday, November 14<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, November 15<sup>th</sup>. We will be offering Novice LD, Varsity LD, Novice PF, and Varsity PF. This year, we are proud to announce that the Scarsdale Invitational has been designated as a **SEMIS BID** in both **Varsity LD** and **Public** Forum. The entry limit will be 5 in each division initially. All teams will be placed on the waiting list initially. I will then clear teams from the waitlist. Entries with names and entries from schools that have continuously demonstrated good citizenship and that have supported our tournament in the past will be given priority. No independent entries will be admitted, and all entries must be entered by degree granting institutions. All entries must be registered through school-based accounts run by a school sanctioned employee.

All rounds (with the exception of doubles) will be single flighted.

We will be debating the November/December resolution for VLD and the NOVICE topic for NLD. We will be using the November PF topic.

There will be 6 preliminary rounds in VLD and VPD and 6 total rounds in NLD and NPF. Prep time will be 4 minutes in LD and 3 minutes in PF

IN PF, THERE WILL BE NO COIN FLIP. PRO SPEAKS FIRST EACH ROUND AND SIDES WILL BE ASSIGNED. We will be using all of the other PF pilot rules – (3 min summary, 3 min prep, open internet FOR RESEARCH ONLY)

Each entry will be offered five strikes in Varsity LD and PF.

### Judging/Chaperoning

The judging ratio for all events is 1 judge for every 2 students or fraction thereof. There are no partial judging commitments allowed. Each judge that is entered is in for the entire tournament, not a certain number of rounds unless you are splitting the judging assignment by day (i.e. one judge fulfills entire Saturday obligation and another the entire Sunday obligation).

This year we will not be allowing varsity kids to compete and judge novice – it's too much. All novice judges must be separate from competitors. A student may judge novice if they are a junior or a senior in minimally their third year of debate.

Every school must have an adult chaperone ON CALL for the ENTIRITY of the tournament. Additionally, the email on record on tabroom.com ought to be a SCHOOL RELATED OFFICIAL, not a student, not an outside person. This person must have functional knowledge of the expectations of what it means to attend a virtual debate tournament and be available all weekend.

To reiterate, no independent entries will be allowed. As tournament director, I do not need to specify what that means. This invitation is not a legal document, simply a method of giving information. Do not try to lawyer me. That will be the clearest way to ensure you will not attend this tournament. If you have questions, ask.

A VERY limited amount of **hired judging** is available. In an online world, you have the same capacity to find people that we can. **We cannot guarantee hired judging to anyone. No school may hire out their entire commitment**. Hired judges will cost \$125 per uncovered entry. We will endeavor to bring in some spectacular neutral judges.

# **Equity and Access**

The Scarsvite is committed to creating a competitive space that is free of harassment and is an open place for communication. We will put out further policies as we approach the tournament to ensure this for our guests.

#### **Fees**

Due to the fact that we are not feeding students this year, I am lowering the fees from last year.

\$60 per VPF team \$40 per VLD entry

\$30 per NPF team \$20 per NLD

\$125 per covered entry judging

All checks should be made payable to SUFSD.

If a judge misses a round, there will be a \$25 fine assessed to the school. If a judge misses a second round, the judge will be dropped from the pool and the school that brought that judge will be fined \$250.

#### The Tentative LD and PF Schedule
