

## Round 1

### A Bill to Prohibit the Use of Tik Tok in the United States

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1.** Tik Tok is a negative open gateway into the cybersecurity of the United States, and with over 500 million users, allows their information to be susceptible to theft. Thus, TikTok shall be banned from operating in the United States and its citizens will no longer be permitted to use the application.

**SECTION 2.** By allowing TikTok to operate within the United States, the personal information of millions of people is put at unnecessary risk.

**SECTION 3.** The U.S. Department of Commerce will oversee this bill. This agency will ensure that the citizens and businesses of the United States will be unable to gain access to, or collaborate with Tik Tok.

**SECTION 4.** This legislation shall go into effect immediately upon passage.

**SECTION 5.** All other laws that are in conflict with this new policy shall hereby be declared null and void.

## **Bill to Reform Election Voting Day**

1 Whereas, each state determines its own election laws and procedures for National Elections,

2 Whereas, the 2006 Carter Center found Mail-In Voting to be the most fraudulent system of

4 Whereas, the Supreme Court is consistently inundated with requests for rulings about diverse

5 and often completely contradictory systems of accepting ballots by states during the Election

6 year,

7 Whereas, the Founding Fathers placed voting as one of the most significant checks and

8 balances for citizens to have a say and express their opinions about their representatives and

9 future of the Nation,

10 Whereas, cases of fraud and mishandling of Mail-In Voting Ballots is increasing across the

11 Nation,

12 Be it enacted by this Student Congress assembled that: A) a system of universal standards

13 and measures be researched and written by a Bipartisan and Citizen Committee on Voting,

14 B) that the written measure of the committee be submitted to the Senate for review,

15 C) the Senate call for a Constitutional Convention within six months after reviewing the

16 Committees findings be called to amend the Constitution of the United States to adopt a

17 universal standard for voting and tabulation in order to guarantee "free and fair"

18 Presidential, while maintaining the present Electoral College System without change.

## Round 2

### A Bill to Create Affordable Internet Service

Be it enacted by the Student Congress here assembled that

**SECTION 1.** the FCC establish a regulated rate for a Basic Internet Service Plan to be available and affordable for all customers of Internet Service Providers

**SECTION 2.** Basic Internet Service Plan is a plan that offers a minimum broadband speed of 100 Mbps download speed and a 10 Mbps upload speed.

**SECTION 3.** The enforcement of said legislation will be upheld by the Federal Communications Commission.

**SECTION 4.** This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.

**SECTION 5.** All other laws that are in conflict with this bill shall hereby be declared null and void.

### A Bill to Ban Federal Involvement in State Regulation of Cannabis Use

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1.

The United States Federal Government shall no longer have the power to interfere with state regulation of cannabis use.

SECTION 2.

Restricting federal involvement will give individual states the right to regulate cannabis for recreational or medical use within their state. State governments will also reserve the right to set their own age restrictions.

SECTION 3.

This will be enacted by establishing a federal penal code that dictates that state governments have jurisdiction over the usage of cannabis within their state.

SECTION 4. This law shall take effect starting in fiscal year 2022.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

### Round 3

#### **A BILL TO END PRICE REGULATION OF THE DAIRY INDUSTRY**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 SECTION 1. The U.S. government will abolish the minimum milk price regulations  
2 enforced by Federal Milk Marketing Orders (FMMOs).

3 SECTION 2. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the FMMOs  
4 will oversee the enforcement of this bill.

5 SECTION 3. This Bill will go into effect on January 1, 2022

6 SECTION 4. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

#### **A Resolution to Reduce Subsidization of Fossil Fuel Companies**

**WHEREAS**, the burning and extraction of fossil fuels continues to contribute to the irreversibility of climate change; and

**WHEREAS**, fossil fuel companies produce the majority of the pollution that causes climate change; and

**WHEREAS**, subsidies promote certain businesses by providing an additional source of revenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Federal Government ranks the worst among the G7 countries for providing \$26 billion annually in 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, extinction from irreversible climate change is entirely avoidable and should be prevented; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Congress here assembled that the United States Federal Government shall immediately end all subsidization of companies that extract or burn fossil fuels.
