1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT: 2 **SECTION 1.** A. The United States shall remove all sanctions placed on the 3 Islamic Republic of Iran since November 5, 2018. 4 B. The United States shall reenter into diplomatic negotiations with Iran including, but not limited to, denuclearization and Iran's 5 6 provocations in the Persian Gulf. 7 C. The United States shall appoint an ambassador (or equivalent) 8 to Iran to oversee negotiations. 9 D. All future US aid to and diplomatic talks with Iran shall not be 10 contingent on Iran's domestic policies. **SECTION 2.** 11 Sanctions shall be defined as all political, commercial, military, 12 and financial penalties imposed on a government, group, or 13 individual. 14 The Office of Foreign Assets Control under the Department of the **SECTION 3.** 15 Treasury shall oversee the enforcement of this bill. 16 **SECTION 4.** This legislation will take effect immediately upon passage. A BILL TO PURCHASE ALL ASSAULT WEAPONS FROM THE AMERICAN PEOPLE BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO REDUCE GUN VIOLENCE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

1 **SECTION 1**.A.The Federal Government will confiscate all assault-style weapons from

2 the American gun-owners and purchase assault weapons from gun owners.

3 **SECTION 2**. Assault weapons will be defined as semiautomatic weapons, weapons

4 able to accept detachable magazines, weapons with any of the following: pistol grip,

5 forward grip, folding, telescoping, or detachable stock, grenade launcher, barrel shroud,

6 or a threaded barrel.

7 **SECTION 3.** The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives shall oversee

8 the enforcement of this legislation. The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and

9 Explosives is a federal law enforcement organization within the Department of Justice.

10 A. The estimated cost of the federal buyback of assault weapons is \$15 billion

11 dollars if all the 15 million assault rifles are bought back at \$1,000 each.

12 **SECTION 4.** This piece of legislation will be implemented on February 14, 2021.

13 **SECTION** 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and

14 void.

13.	SECTION 4. This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2023.
14.	SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and
15.	void.
