Judge Requirements

You will owe the following obligations - We have changed something for this regional. Congressional judges will now be in the Debate Judges pool.

- 1 Judge Per 10 IE Entries
- 1 Judge Per 5 Debate/Congress Entries

Drops after Monday January 25th at 4pm (Judges and Entries) - \$25

Missed Rounds during Tournament (including missing from judge pool) - \$25

Missing Judges - \$60

Changes made prior to online registration are \$25. Changes made during the tournament or post online registration are \$35. It's the coaches responsibility to confirm their entry.

We've divided the obligations up to equal \$60 - You must mark your availability. If you don't do this and then are assigned a round you are unable to judge, that is the same as a 'missing round' fee which is \$25 per ballot.

Notes for Coaches

Novice Congressional has been added for this Regional. Please refer to the ACTAA Qualifying Document for the definition of "Novice" in debate. Coaches do have the ability to challenge students who they believe shouldn't be in said divisions.

Prior to entries being accepted- Schools must complete the following:

- Entry Information (Due January 25th)
 - Piece Title/Author/Publication Information
- Waivers for Each Student Competing (Due January 25th)
 - Located on the ACTAA Website along with the Google Drive

Impromptu and Extemp are Live. Students will speak in the order they are listed on Tabroom. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus. **Students may only enter ONE live event. They cannot be double entered in multiple live events due to the nature of the schedule.** Debate is live. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus

Other IEs are recorded. These will be listed as 'link sharing only' on youtube and links will be posted on specific entries. These are due on January 25th at 4pm.

THE PASSWORD THAT MUST BE HELD OR POSTED ON THE WALL AT THE START OF EACH VIDEO IS "LOVE ACCTALY" IF A PASSWORD ISN'T HELD UP, THE ENTRY WILL BE UNABLE TO COMPETE.

IE piece information needs to be uploaded to Tabroom by January 25th at 4pm. Failure to upload piece information will result in an inability to compete with no refund.
