RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each school will get 18 total entries. Every 5 (or portion there-of) over that number will require a judge.
2. Students may enter in as many events as you are comfortable giving them.
3. Prose and Poetry must be read. With the exception of a small step for transitions, the performer's feet shall not move.
4. Duo MUST be recorded on the split screen. No submissions of non split screen will be allowed to compete.
5. In extemp prep, we will be following current KSHSAA guidelines regarding the use of Electronic Retrieval Devices. Questions will come from digital and print sources.
6. Medals will be given to the top 6 finalists in each event.
7. Sweepstakes will be determined by your top 18 entries prelim records. Plaques will be awarded to the top two sweepstakes schools overall.
8. Management reserves the right to handle situations as they may arise to best facilitate student learning.
9. Students must be representing an actual school. No independent teams will be allowed to compete.
