CLASSES: This is a virtual qualifying tournament for classes 3A and 4A in all fourteen events, which will run according to the rules set by the OSSAA. Since this is a virtual tournament, we will NOT be hosting Novice or Champs.

TABROOM.COM TO DO'S: Register as soon as possible as a coach and judge. Have your students and judges register, and then link them to your school.

ENTRIES: There is a maximum of 5 entries per debate events. As long as you provide the appropriate number of judges, there are unlimited i.e. entries; otherwise, the maximum entries are 5 per event.

DEADLINE: Entries are due by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 25. Register on tabroom.com @ <http://okeeneinvitational.tabroom.com>

DROPS/ADDS: See the OSSAA rule book for drop fees. Adds will be taken until Tuesday, January 26, at 5:00 p.m. Drops and name changes are due by Wednesday, January 27 at 5:00 p.m. Nuisance fees (drop fees and missing judge fees) are imposed on Tuesday, January 26 at 5:00 p.m.

ASYNCHRONOUS: All events except extemp and debate will be pre-recorded. Video uploads are due by Tuesday, January 26 at 5:00 p.m.

SYNCHRONOUS: Extemp and debate will be live virtually on Saturday, January 30.

JUDGES: Confirm by Wednesday, January 27 by 5:00 p.m.

Requirements are as follows:

CX: 1 judge for 1-2 teams, 2 judges for 3-4 teams, 3 judges for 5 teams

LD: 1 judge for 1-4 debaters, 2 judges for 5 debaters

PF: 1 judge for 1-4 teams, 2 judges for 5 teams

IE: 1 judge for 1-12 entries, 2 judges for 12-24 entries, etc.

COST: The cost is \$4 for each individual event, \$5 for each LD debate entry, \$8 for duets, and \$10 for each CX and/or PF debate team.

PAYMENT: Make checks and purchase orders out to Okeene High School Drama Dept. An invoice will be sent to you after the completion of the tournament.

AWARDS: Medals will be presented to the top three places in individual events and in debate, along with speaker awards. Sweepstakes plaques will also be awarded to the top three teams in each class. These will be mailed to you.

SCHEDULE: A schedule of events will be sent to you the week of the tournament.

PATIENCE: Let's all have some; virtual is new to all of us!

OTHER VIRTUAL STUFF:

Make sure you are registered and listed as eligible with the OSSAA BEFORE you enter this contest and that all students entered are on your roster.

NSDA campus will only work with Google Chrome. Please be sure that you and your students are using it as your browser. Also, you and your students will want to constantly refresh tabroom.

Be sure before you upload your entries that the privacy settings are set so that the judges will be able to open the links and view the videos. (EX: YouTube videos marked as unlisted vs. private)
