## **Registration**

- ❑ All registration will be online at [www.tabroom.com](http://www.tabroom.com)
- ❑ Registration is open to all 9th-12th grade representing the schools they attend.
- ❑ No independent student entries will be accepted.
- ❑ Registration will open on January 28th at 7 am.
- ❑ Deadline for adds is February 12th at 9 pm.
- ❑ **Recorded IE deadline is February 15th at 5 pm.**
- ❑ Deadline for drops (without fees) is February 15th at 5 pm.

## **Events**

- ❑ IE's include: Humorous, Dramatic, Duo, Poetry, Prose, Impromptu, Extemp, Inform, Oratory, ADS, POI, LIELL, and Radio.
- ❑ Senior divisions will be offered if enough students register for all events.
- ❑ Debate includes: Lincoln-Douglas, Public Forum, Big Questions, and Parli.

## **IMPORTANT**

- ❑ Teams must have an adult available throughout the tournament. A reachable phone number must be provided during registration.
- ❑ **DUO and Partnered Debates:** Students must follow the guidance of their schools and legal guardians when competing in these events. Judges will be instructed to honor the decisions of the schools/legal guardians and not judge based on proximity.

## **Judges**

- ❑ All judges must be registered through Tabroom. Judges may sign up for both live and recorded events.
- ❑ Recorded events- Judges should register as an asynchronous judge. These judges will be assigned preliminary rounds on February 16th by 8 am. Preliminary round ballots will be due on February 18th by 4 pm. Final rounds will be assigned on February 18th by 8 pm. Final round ballots will be due on February 19th at 11:59 pm.
- ❑ Live events- Judges should register as synchronous judges for days available.
- ❑ Judging fees- Teams not meeting the minimum requirement will be charged.
- ❑ Schools should make sure their judges have had preliminary judges training or explanation of judging requirements. Click [here](#) for some NSDA resources for judges.

### **Ultimate Challenge and Entry Rules:**

**Schools are limited to 4 talented lunatics in the Ultimate Challenge.**

**IMPORTANT: Schools must identify their UC students no later than February 12th by filling out this [form](#).**

**No one may double enter in the same pattern except for Ultimate Challengers.**

Ultimate Challengers must enter between 5 and 7 events, with no more than 3 to a pattern. Four of these events must be LIVE with up to 3 being recorded. Those events must include, in addition to whatever events complete their individual Challenge:

1. A Memorized Original Speech (Informative or Oratory)
2. A Memorized Interpretation (HI, DI, or POI)
3. A Debate (PF, LD or Parli)
4. Impromptu
