Judge Requirements

We don't have strict tournament requirements for judges. This is the recommendation below -

1 Judge = 15 Speech Entries

1 Judge = 10 Congress/Debate Entries

Hired Judge/Missing Judge- \$20

Drops after February 25th (Judges and Entries) - \$10

Notes for Coaches

Prior to entries being accepted- Schools must have waivers for each student competing

WE ARE NOT REQUIRING PIECE INFORMATION - BUT SCHOOLS MUST HAVE THAT INFORMATION AS NEEDED. ALL THAT NEEDS SUBMITTED IS THE PIECE TITLE/AUTHOR.



Impromptu and Extemp are Live. Students will speak in the order they are listed on Tabroom. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus. Students can only compete in Extemp or Impromptu (NOT BOTH) If students are registered in both, there will be no refund after the deadline and one of the entries will need to be dropped.

Debate is live. Rounds will occur on NSDA Campus
