We would like to invite you to the April Fools Last Chance Forensics Tournament to be held on Thursday, April 1st. This will be jointly run by Abilene and Clay Center. This tournament will be entirely synchronous and run through zoom. We will be offering Duo Interp/Duet Acting, Improvised Duet Acting, Impromptu, Extemp, Informative 7, Informative 10, Original Oration, Program of Oral Interp, Humorous Interp (or HSA), Dramatic Interp (or SSA), Prose, and Poetry. Entries will be \$6 for individual, \$12 for duo/duet events.

All entries will be waitlisted until a judge is provided in tabroom. We require 1 judge per 6 entries or portion thereof. Students may enter in two events and may not enter both IDA and Extemp. No, Impromptu cannot be a 3rd. This is a LAST CHANCE tournament, meaning no entries that have qualified for state are allowed. Please don't be that person.

We are going to be running hour and 15 minute rounds. It will be VITAL that students get to their rooms early and perform. If they have not performed by the end of the round, then they forfeit, no exceptions. All students MUST have a linked tabroom account to compete at this tournament, if you need help with that please contact one of us.

While we would love to be able to afford medals, we can't. We may have something up our sleeves though as far as prizes. We will also be able to do certificates. No sweepstakes.
