Process to Accept Qualification Spots for NCFL Nationals

In order to avoid paper commitment forms, I am going to leverage registering through a <u>tabroom.com</u> tournament that I have set up for the purposes of NCFL registration.

Coaches with students who have qualified will enter them in this registration tournament to indicate acceptance of the spots. Entry fees for NCFL Nationals will be \$60 per student, so in the case of Duo, PF, and Policy, the entry fee is \$120.

Please make sure you enter you students in the appropriate Diocese (Washington is for DC and Maryland Schools; Arlington is for Virginia Schools)

You will also enter your judges there and it will show your judge commitment requirements. For reference, the judge commitment requirements are as follows:

- Speech: 1 judge for every 2 speech entries or portion thereof.
- Lincoln-Douglas Debate: 1.5 judges for every LD debater
- Public Foum Debate: 1.5 judges for every PF team
- Policy Debate: 1.5 judges for every Policy team
- Student Congress: 3 judges for each diocese with 2 of them being Parliamentarian qualified

It will also create an invoice that we will use to send a bill to the coach so that you can pay it electronically.

Please note that by entering qualified students (or a call-up student if I notify you of that event), you are committing them to attend. You are also committing to supplying the required number of judges.

In the event that your students or judges do not show for the tournament or any assigned rounds, you are committing to pay any associated fines.

If you can not accept the conditions noted above, please do not enter any students or judges.
