The Gold Public Forum RR is for teams competing in Gold PF at this year's Tournament of Champions.

The Silver Public Forum RR is for teams competing in Silver PF at this year's Tournament of Champions.*

*All at-large applicants to GTOC will be in the silver pool pending any changes in their division status— all accepted at-larges will be moved over into the gold pool!
