Entries

- ❑ Any student may enter up to 2 IEs and 1 Debate event.
- ❑ A school may have no more than 3 entries in any event up to a maximum of 29 Individual Events. CX, Public Forum, Parli, and LD entries do not count towards this 29-entry limit, but you may have no more than 3 entries in each of these debate events.
- ❑ Congress entries will be determined by each district. Please contact your district director for more information.
- ❑ DUO will be split screen submission only.

Speech Submission

Please submit speeches to your district director via Dropbox prior to the district tournament. District directors will be running the speeches through plagiarism checking software prior to the start of the tournament. **Links to the dropboxes will be emailed to you by your district director.**

IMPORTANT

- ❑ Teams must have an adult available throughout the tournament. A reachable phone number must be provided during registration.

Judges

- ❑ All judges must be registered through Tabroom. Judges may sign up for both live and recorded events.
- ❑ Recorded events- Judges should register as an asynchronous judge. See deadlines on schedule.
- ❑ Live events- Judges should register as synchronous judges for days available.
- ❑ Judging fees- Teams not meeting the minimum requirement will be charged.
- ❑ Schools should make sure their judges have had preliminary judges training or explanation of judging requirements. Click [here](#) for some NSDA resources for judges.

Judging Obligations

Please bring judges, especially judges with no school affiliation. Please bring enough judges to cover your entry, using the formula **one judge covers five entries**. ***We will be using online ballots, so make sure your judges have tabroom accounts.***

Asynchronous judges are due Monday, April 5th by 5 pm.
Synchronous judges can be added at any time.
