<p>REMINDERS/ NOTES (This portion may have more info added throughout the tournament as issues come up.)</p>	<p>***Do not have more than one video call/link open at a time. This means that you must leave the judges room before going to the competition rooms.</p> <p>***You may have non-performing competitors turn off their cameras in round if the connection seems to be weak. However, it is expected that competitors use their camera while performing.</p>

<p>TRAINING</p>	<p>We recommend this training and reading through the rules packets on tabroom before judging.</p>
<p>CHECK IN</p>	<p>Check in through the "Judge Room" on tabroom. This is how we will know you are ready to judge. See below.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>
<p>CHECK OUT</p>	<p>Please let the Judge Staff in the Judge Room know that you will be checking out. If you do not let us know, we will continue to assign ballots to you which will then put us behind schedule.</p> <p>We will also provide a phone number for texting the tab staff if there are issues during a round.</p>
