## Policy Debate

Topic: "Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially increase its protection of water resources in the United States in one or more of the following areas: drinking water, hydraulic fracturing, and/or agricultural use of water."

Time limits:

5 min. constructives

2 min. cross-examination

3 min. rebuttals

3 min. prep time

## Extemporaneous

20 minute preparation time to present a 4 minute speech answering a question about current events. Students may access articles and evidence gathered prior to the contest, but they may not use the internet during preparation. Topics will be released 3 weeks ahead of tournament

## Oratory

Students present a memorized 6-8 minute speech on a persuasive topic.
