Events

We'll be offering the following events in the following patterns:

We will not be offering CX at our tournament – sorry

A few notes about events:

first, we will be using the March LD and PF topics ([linked](#));

second, **all** events will have three preliminary rounds;

third, extemp will feature a mix of international and domestic questions taken from December, January, and February NSDA/NFHS questions (on the NSDA site);

fourth, we will have a *wide* variety of humans judging for us throughout the weekend. They have all been trained and are well aware of NSDA requirements and expectations. :);

fifth, ties in debate will be broken by power of opposition, then by speaker points;

finally, legislation will be taken from the Wyo Legislation folder. If you want it included, please have it uploaded/your student entered by no later than **Friday, February 25th, 2022**. Legislation will be sent out on **Sunday, February 27th, 2022**.

Registration

Pre-registration will begin today and is due by **Wednesday, February 23, 2022**.

Entries can be **added** until **Tuesday, March 2, 2022**.

Name changes or drops can happen until **9:AM on March 4, 2022**.

Fees

Individual events will be \$10 per entry. Partnered events will be \$16 per entry. There will be a cap on entries (four per school per event), but more may be admitted if space allows.

We will **not** be administering drop fees but if a drop occurs **after 9:AM on Friday, March 4**, the entry fee will be charged.

Doubling

Students may double or triple in any one pattern at their own risk.

- Extempers may not receive complete prep time.
- LDers and PFers may double in The Ds pattern but if they are more than 15 minutes late to a debate round, they will have to forfeit.

Judging

Teams will be required to submit one judge per three entries. If teams submit three entries in one event, a judge they provide must be able to judge that event exclusively.

Awards

First place in all events will receive medals. Second through sixth in all events will receive certificates and ribbons.

Sweepstakes will be awarded to the top two schools in each division (two or three divisions, based on the size/number of schools present).

All awards will be sent to schools as soon as they arrive (send all the positive vibes to the shipping routes and humans in charge of them, please and thank you!)
