

Glacier High School in Kalispell, Montana will host an "in-person" Speech & Debate tournament on Friday, January 7th, and Saturday, January 8th, 2022. All teams are invited!

Entry Dead line: Your completed registration is due no later than 4:00 pm, Wednesday, December 22nd on TABROOM.COM. You make any changes to your entry up through 4:00 pm, Wednesday, January 5th. Changes to the Registration after the deadline must be made through email (adkinsg@sd5.k12.mt.us) or by calling Greg Adkins at GHS (406) 758-8668 or cell phone at (406) 309-5065. ENTRIES: There will not be a limit on entries! Bring everyone, however, only 42 entries (with a max of 4 in an event) in each event will be tabulated for sweepstake points. Events include Varsity Policy Debate, Novice Policy Debate, Varsity LD Debate, Novice LD Debate, Public Forum Debate, Legislative Debate, Extemp, Impromptu, Original Oratory, Informative Speaking, Memorized Public Address, Program Oral Interp, Dramatic Interp, Humorous Interp, and Duo Interp. The 42 (max of 4) varsity roster must be submitted to the sweepstake tab persons BEFORE the first round on Friday.

RULES: All events will be conducted according to the MHSA Handbook except Debaters may enter a speech event! (Your Debate event + 1 speech event). Speech students may enter a debate event (Speech event + 1 debate event). Non-Debaters may enter triple-enter in speech events. For debate ballots and judges comment sheets see the forms page on the MHSA site. Click on Debate ballots and AA Speech Events for current ballots and expectations.

SCHEDULE: All events will have the traditional AA schedule (Speech 5 rounds plus Semifinals & Finals, Debate 5 rounds, plus Quarterfinals, Semifinals and Finals, Drama 3 rounds, plus Semifinals & Finals).

FEES: Each participant will be charged a \$5.00 entry fee plus a \$25 team fee. There will be a \$5.00 charge for all drops and/or adds made after the January 5th deadline. In order to keep costs down, we may not use TABROOM to tab the tournament. Depending on the size, we will consider hand-tabbing or using another tabbing program.

REGISTRATION: There will be no on-site registration. I will share code #s and tabbing assignments on Thursday. Please check your registration carefully and notify me immediately of any problems/changes.

BUILDINGS: All events will be held at Glacier High School.

CONCESSIONS: Full concessions may not be available on site. More information after Christmas break!

AWARDS: Awards Assembly will be held on Saturday at 6:30 pm in the PERFORMANCE HALL at Glacier High. Awards and certificates will be given to the finalists in every event. Awards will be given to the top three teams in "AA" and in "ABC".
