The tournament defines novice and varsity as follows:

<u>Varsity LD or PF</u>: A student who competed in 11 or more rounds of debate in the school year 2020-21; or, any student who competed in any debate rounds in the school year 2019-20. If one person on a CX or PF team meets the standards of Varsity, the team must be registered as Varsity.

<u>Novice LD</u>, or <u>PF</u>: A student who has not competed before the current school year, or who competed in less than 11 rounds of debate last school year. If one student in a CX or PF team qualifies as Varsity, the team must compete as Varsity.

*Novice and Varsity event categories are subject to change due to number of entries. If there are not enough entries in either category, the event might be collapsed into one debate category.

Double Entry: A student may double in various events as long as the events are not scheduled at the same time. For example, a student may enter in a speech event and debate event, but a student could not

double enter in extemp and another speech event.
