Registration Info: Register your team on Tabroom.com starting on January 24. The deadline is <u>6pm on Tuesday, February 1</u>. Schools are obligated to fulfill judging commitments and cover entry fees which become binding at 6pm on Tuesday, February 1.

Linking Students in Tabroom: All competitors will need a Tabroom account linked to your team roster. This handy <u>video</u> will help you link your students' accounts.

Judges: One well-trained judge for every eight Congress entries. Judges are obligated for both sessions.

Rules: We will follow Wisconsin Forensic Coaches' Association rules. Students are <u>strongly encouraged</u>, but not required, to turn their cameras on even while not speaking during session.

Technology: If you have students or judges who have not used NSDA Campus before, they should run a <u>TEST</u> beforehand to make sure their equipment will allow them to participate.

Legislation: Upload your bills to Tabroom by Saturday, January 29 at noon. **All bills must be uploaded as a Word file** (<u>not</u> a Google doc or pdf). Please use the templates available on the MUHS Congress Tabroom site. Legislation packets will be published on Tabroom no later than Saturday, January 29 at 6pm. Only legislation uploaded by Saturday, January 29 at noon will be allowed during the chambers' debate. NOTE: In order to upload legislation, you must first register at least one student.
