Procedures

Videos are due on Mondays at 5 PM. Draw event topics will be posted on Sundays to the Tabroom.com webpage of the tournament(s). Student performances should be shared as unlisted YouTube links. **Videos must state the start date of the tournament at the opening of the piece.** This is to help with the pedagogical progression that we as educators and coaches need for our students. Preliminary rounds will be judged by Wednesday at 5 PM. Final rounds will be judged by Thursday at 8 PM. Results will be shared in a Tabroom.com email. No awards. But, it's a great opportunity for students to get feedback, compete, learn and grow, and potentially qualify for state.

One judge per 6 entries is required. No exceptions. **Note a 4 entry limit per student in each tournament, please.**
