Registration

- Registration is DUE March 30th @ 5pm**
- JUDGES- Please note if your judge is available Friday, Saturday, or Both.**

Entries

- Any student may enter up to 2 IEs and 1 Debate event.
- A school may have no more than 3 entries in any event up to a maximum of 29 Individual Events. CX, Public Forum, Parli, and LD entries do not count towards this 29-entry limit, but you may have no more than 3 entries in each of these debate events.
- Congress entries will be determined by each district.* Please contact your district director for more information.

Speech Submission

Please submit speeches to your **district director** via Dropbox prior to the district tournament. District directors will be running the speeches through plagiarism checking software prior to the start of the tournament. **Links to the dropboxes will be emailed to you by your district director.**

IMPORTANT

- Teams must have an adult available throughout the tournament. A reachable phone number must be provided during registration.
- Internet use is prohibited for all events per OSAA Rules.**

Judges

- All judges must be registered through Tabroom.
- All events will be synchronous.
- Judging fees- Teams not meeting the minimum requirement will be charged.

Please bring judges, especially judges with no school affiliation. Please bring enough judges to cover your entry, using the formula **one judge covers five entries**. ***We will be using online ballots, so make sure your judges have tabroom accounts.***
