## AP Summer Invitational, UDM (Unified Debaters of Massachusetts), Summer 2022

Welcome to the UDM AP Summer Invitational! Below are our tournament policies which should give you a general idea of how the tournament will operate during the weekend. If you have any questions, the tournament organizers are free to field them as we approach the tournament date.

#### Overview

This tournament will be in AP (American Parliamentary) style online during the weekend of July 29th to 31st. The goal is to have an open break to quarterfinals, but may change if size requires, and will be using the AP Format. We will have 5 in-rounds and 3 out-rounds, which will all have impromptu motions. Prep time will be 30 minutes for all rounds.

### **Eligibility**

This tournament is a registered open. Any current school student is eligible to form a team (including those who have just recently graduated in the last few months and are awaiting the start of their first year of University in May or later). You must register as a team of 2 students, rather than as an individual. Students do not need to attend the same school/institution to form a team together.

There will be a single open break, which will comprise the entire pool of competitors. However, speaker awards will be given for different categories. This will include International and Open debaters.

#### **Technical details**

This tournament will be run over zoom. Depending on the technology preferences of those registered, we will also be hosting over discord. If this poses a significant problem there may be an alternative found.

## **Registration and Fees**

Registration will open on **May 12th** and will close once we hit our team cap (around 75 teams but depends on judges) or **June 30th**, whichever happens first. All payment must be made within one week of the reg deadline. Registration fees will be set at 90 USD (inclusive of: 2 speaking members, 0-2 coaches/observers, 1 judge). You are required to bring one judge less than each team you register. This is an *n-1* judging requirement. If you are unable to bring judges, a fee of 45 USD will be applied. Payment can be made via Venmo, Paypal, or Direct Deposit. A payment

plan will be negotiated team by team to ensure it is amicable for both parties. A limited amount of fee waivers will be given, with priority given to those who would face financial hardship by attending and paying the reg.
