A Bill to Establish a Carbon Tax

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1. A \$25 per tonne tax shall be levied on all carbon dioxide emissions.
 - A. The carbon tax shall increase 1% annually.
- SECTION 2. All capital collected from the carbon tax shall be used for funding renewable energy initiatives.
- SECTION 3. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) shall be responsible for overseeing this legislation as well as enforcing necessary punishment.
 - A. Companies that do not fulfill the requirements of this shall face a penalty of 200% of the amount originally owed.
- SECTION 4. The bill shall take effect one year after passage.
- SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Provide Military Training to Civilians in Ethiopia to Fight Off the Rebel Tigray Forces

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The United States government will send members of the United States military (that volunteer) to Ethiopia to train civilians to fight the rebel Tigray in their country, especially the TPLF. Those who volunteer will be given a paycheck of \$2,000 for their aid.

SECTION 2. Military training shall be defined as formal or informal instruction of foreign students in the United States or overseas by officers or employees of the United States, contract technicians, contractors (including instruction at civilian institutions), or by correspondence courses, technical, educational, training aids, and military advice. The Tigray War shall be defined as an ongoing civil war that began on November 3, 2020 in the Tigray Region of Ethiopia. The TLPF (Tigrayan People's Liberation Front) shall be defined as a rebel Tigray political party that is on the top ten list of most harmful terrorists.

SECTION 3. The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and The U.S. Department of Defense

A. USAID will help with the overall implementation, while the DOD will oversee the training included in the bill.

SECTION 4. This bill will go into effect January 1, 2023

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
