A Resolution To Increase Funding for Desalination Plants in California

1	WHEREAS,	California is experiencing a long term shortage of fresh water.
2	WHEREAS,	California voters passed propositions in 2004 & 2014 to fund desalination
3		plants; and
4	WHEREAS,	The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) has limited to
5		funding for grants to fund desalination plant grants in California; and
6	WHEREAS,	there is little timeframe to help the water crisis, and desalination plants
7		are one of the realistic solutions to California's drought, therefore be it
8	RESOLVED,	by the Student Congress here assembled, that the California government
9		fund the DWR one billion dollars over the next ten years to enable it to
10		continue to provide grants for desalination plant projects throughout the
11		state.

A Resolution to Shut Down the FISA Court

1	WHEREAS,	Following the withdrawal from Afghanistan, the use of warrantless
2		searches and mass surveillance has become outdated and preys on the
3		security of American citizens, and
3	WHEREAS,	Over the 1000's warrantless searches authorized, less than 1% have
4		actually been done on terror suspicions, and have instead targeted
5		minorities, and
6	WHEREAS,	Of the 200,000 personal internet records demanded from Internet Service
7		Providers, only 1 terror-related conviction occurred which would
8		have occurred without warrantless searches, and
9	WHEREAS,	The FISA court raises the problem of distorting the checks and balances
10		by expanding executive power; be it
11	RESOLVED,	By the Congress here, assembled that the United States shut down the
12		FISA Court and ban the use of mass surveillance and warrantless
13		searches.

A Resolution to Increase Targeted Arm Sales to Taiwan

1	WHEREAS,	Current arm sales to Taiwan do not reflect the weapons needed to defend
2		itself against an invasion from China; and
3	WHEREAS,	Ukraine's conflict with Russia has taught us that small scale weapons
4		are necessary for smaller countries to defend itself against larger
5		powers through the use asymmetric warfare; and
6	WHEREAS,	US Secretary of State Antony Blinken has called for the Taiwan authorities
7		to strengthen "asymmetric defense capabilities." Therefore, be it
8	RESOLVED,	By the Congress here assembled that the United States transition its arms
9		sales to Taiwan to focus on small scale weapon systems such as stingers,
10		javelins and other weapon systems that can repel a seaborne invasion by
11		China.
