



Jefferson Debate is happy to invite you to our 2nd Cavalier Invite! Important information includes:

1. ALL speech and interp events will be ASYNC
 - a. Recordings are due on Tuesday Jan 31st
 - b. Judging will be from Wednesday the 1st through Friday the 3rd.
 - c. There will be four rounds of competition
 - d. Extemp questions will be posted on Sunday
 - e. Awards will be presented/announced on Saturday along with debate
 - f. I will notify coaches on Saturday morning if they have a student who will be up for awards so they can try and get students there for awards
2. Varsity and JV Public Forum and Lincoln-Douglas will be offered
 - a. 5 Prelim rounds with ALL 3-2 records breaking to the out rounds
 - b. 4 rounds on Friday night
 - c. Rd 5 Saturday morning followed by out rounds
 - d. Those not making it to the out rounds can compete in Extemp Debate!
3. Extemporaneous Debate Supplemental Event
 - a. Students can pre-register for Extemp debate which will happen after prelims
 - b. Any student who pre-registered and did not break to the out rounds will be entered
 - c. 3 Prelim rounds with a final held during other debate finals
 - d. Debates will be triple-flighted
4. Congressional Debate
 - a. In trying to make Congress follow national styles and to get ready for Quals, there will be a couple of slight changes to congress
 - b. 3 Preliminary sessions (if there is more than one house) with a Final session on Saturday afternoon
 - c. This means that you need to identify someone as a Congress judge. I plan on using the same judges for Friday and different ones for Saturday morning and then new judges for the finals (if possible).
 - d. Students who don't make finals will be allowed to participate in Extemp debate
5. **Mount Rushmore Awards!**
 - a. There will be 4 special awards given out this year based upon performances at the Washington Warrior, Roosevelt Sweetstakes, Lincoln Silver Bowl and Jefferson Cavalier Invite:
 - i. Washington – Top Individual Events
 - ii. Roosevelt – Top Debate Performance
 - iii. Lincoln – Top Combined Performance
 - iv. Jefferson – Best Team Performance
