- Judge training will be offered during Rounds 1 and 2.

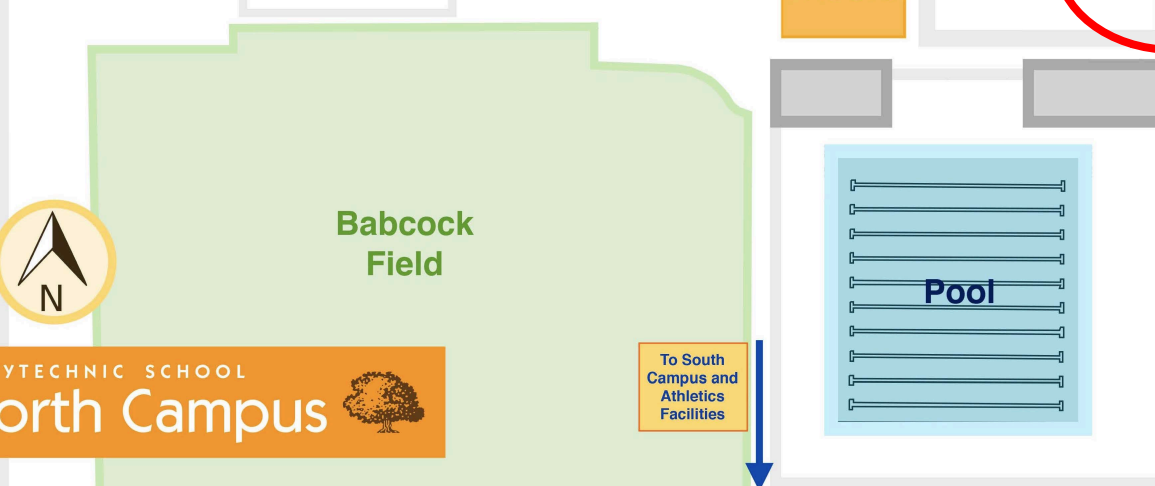
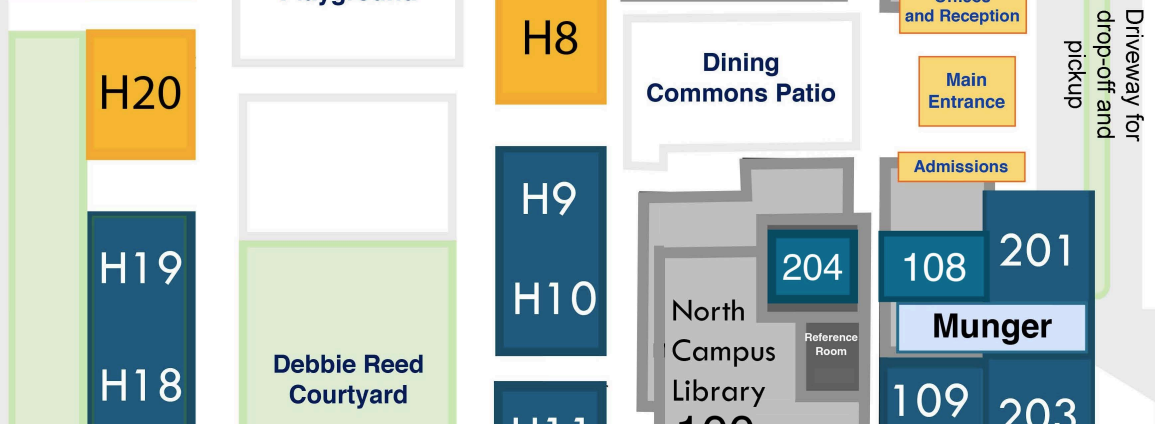
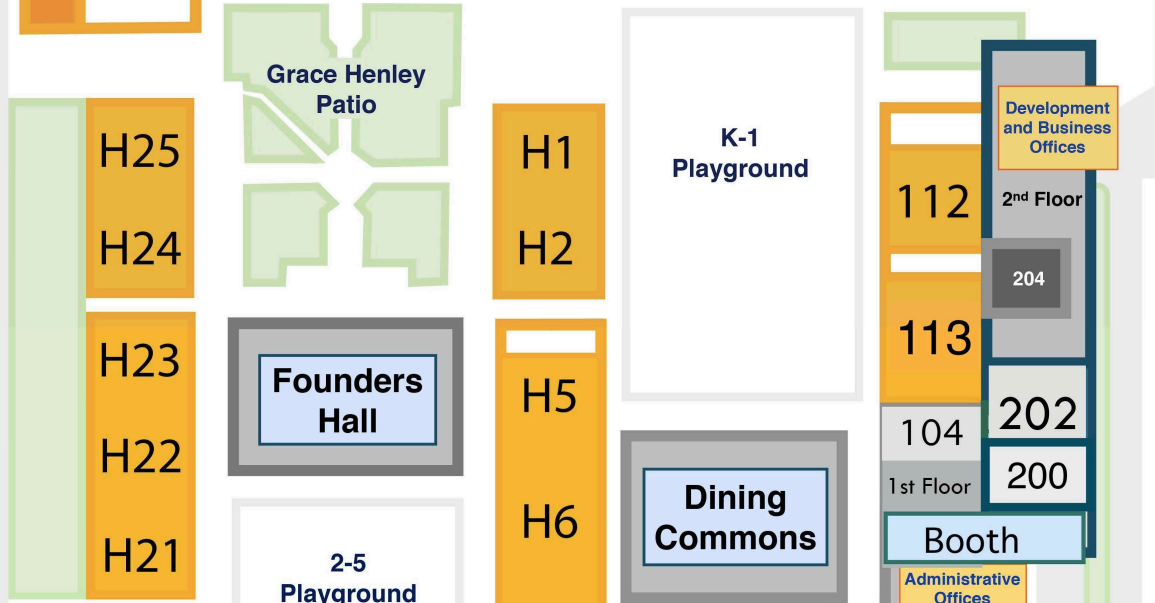
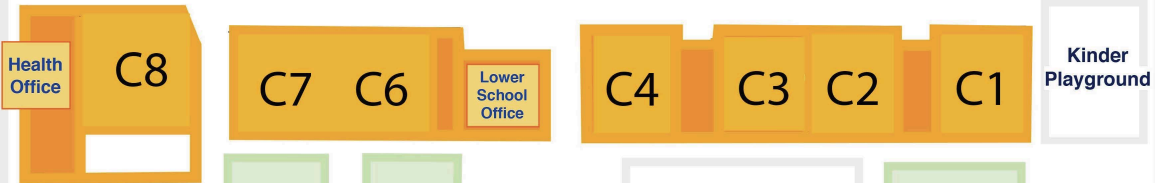
