

2022 Middleton Debate Tournament: Saturday, December 17th ONLINE - NSDA CAMPUS

Divisions: Three rounds of Policy – Novice and Varsity. Novice is defined as first year high school competitor. Five rounds of LD and PF - JV and Varsity. JV is defined as first- or second-year high school competitor. Middle School debate is welcome in the novice division. Please keep any oral comments after the round to a minimum.

Policy prep time is 10 minutes. LD prep time is 5 minutes. PF prep time is 4 minutes. Each team gets 15 minutes per round of tech time to resolve technology issues.

Topics:

- Policy Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially increase its security cooperation with the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in one or more of the following areas: artificial intelligence, biotechnology, cybersecurity.
- LD Resolved: The People's Republic of China ought to prioritize environmental protection over economic growth.
- PF Resolved: The United States' strategy of Great Power Competition produces more benefits than harms.

Judge Requirements: 1 judge per 1-2 entries or any fraction thereof. LD and PF are separate judging pools.

Tech Issues: Tech issues during the tournament can go to tech@wdca.org.

Inclusion Concerns: If there are any concerns during the tournament related to accessing debate, discrimination, or inappropriate conduct, please email <u>dei@wdca.org</u> and the appointed tournament ombudsmen will be happy to address the concerns with the parties involved.
