SID Fox **Speech** Information:

The tournament will be held Saturday, November 5th, 2022. We offer all State individual events. Awards will be given out to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place entries in Open Division and Novice Division. Certificates will be presented to finalists in all divisions.

REGISTRATION:

- Please enter online at: <http://sidfoxspeech.tabroom.com>
- Initial registration is due Monday, October 31st at 4:00 pm.
- Changes to your registration will be accepted until 5:00 pm on Wednesday, November 2nd. Fees will be assessed at that time.
- **Please get your complete registration in, including judges, as early as possible. Remember: it is always easier to drop students than to add them later.**
- Late Drops: If you have drops after we close registration, we will allow you to make those yourself on Tabroom. However, we will assess fees on Wednesday the 2nd at 5:00 pm; any drops made after that time will still be charged.

IE DIVISIONS:

- Novice Division: Limited to students with NO SPEAKING EXPERIENCE IN HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITION BEFORE THE 2022-2023 school year.
- Open Division: Open to all students.
- Note: Divisions may be collapsed if there are insufficient entries.

PATTERNS:

Pattern A: Duo, Radio, Prose, POI, Inform, Extemp

Pattern B: Impromptu, HI, ADS, LIELL, Oratory, DI, Poetry

CONFLICTS:

1. Students may enter 2 conflicting Individual Events per pattern *at their own risk*. The only exception is Extemp - - students who are entered in Extemp MAY NOT enter another event in Pattern A. We do not recommend entering two 10-minute events in the same pattern.
2. Extemp will prep in the hour of their pattern - it will be important that Extempers are not late to the prep room!

Entry Limitations:

First Come-First Served. If we run into spatial constraints, you may be asked to make adjustments. **Those with uncovered entries will be the first to be asked to adjust their registration, so please ensure that you are finding judges to cover your entries.**

FOOD:

RULES:

**For all IE events, OSAA State rules will apply.*

JUDGES:

*Each team must provide 1 coach available to supervise students and judge throughout the tournament. If your coach is unable to attend, or if they are going to be on the opposite campus for this day, please inform the tournament director of the name of the adult in charge by listing them on the Tabroom site for the appropriate tournament.

*One judge covers 6 entries.

*Please note that **judges cannot cover both the Speech and the Debate portions of the tournament, as they are on separate campuses**. Make sure that you have entered judges correctly on Tabroom, and that judges understand what they will be covering for the day.

****Judges covering entries are expected to be available throughout the entire tournament.**
