You are cordially invited to the Highlands Falling in Love with Forensics Tournament hosted by Highlands Middle School in Ft. Thomas, KY. Our tournament will be held on **November 19**, **2022**, at Highlands Middle School Campus.

REGISTRATION:

- Register on Tabroom.com or on this link: http://highlandsms.tabroom.com
- The registration deadline is Tuesday 11/15 @ 9:00 pm. All student entries and judges must be in by this time.

CATEGORIES OFFERED:

- This tournament offers all KHSSL, Inc. events for the Junior divisions.
- Please ensure that you and your judges are familiar with the rules and guidelines in the updated <u>KHSSL</u>, <u>Inc. Handbook</u>.

ENTRIES:

- Teams may have unlimited entries; however, only the top three scores in each event will count toward team sweepstakes.
- Individual students may enter no more than three events.

JUDGES:

- Each school must provide one (1) judge per six (6) entries. 1-6 entries = 1 judge; 7-12 entries = 2 judges; 13-18 entries = 3 judges, etc.
- No team can register without at least one (1) judge.
- Your team may hire up to three (3) judges at a cost of \$30 each.
- Tabroom will not allow you to register a judge who does not already have a Tabroom account linked to your team.
- A brief judge training will be provided the morning of the tournament, but it will not be an all-encompassing judge
 training. Judges should be familiar with the Tabroom website, how to complete online ballots, and the KHSSL rules
 prior to tournament day.
- We will use online ballots, so all judges should have a tablet or laptop on competition day. Judging on a phone is not ideal.

SCHEDULE ON SATURDAY 11/19:

• Please note that I have given extra time between the final round and finals. If the tournament runs early I will keep the momentum and run finals and awards early as well.

AWARDS:

- We will award medals for 1st-6th place.
- The top six teams will receive a sweepstakes plaque.

FEES:

- Entry fees are \$6 per individual event. (Duo events are \$12).
- Student drop fees (\$10 for each drop past the registration deadline) begin Tuesday 11/15 @ 9:01 pm.
- Judge drop fees (\$30 for each drop past the registration deadline) begin Tuesday 11/15 @ 9:01 pm.

PAYMENT:

• Please make checks out to *Highlands Middle School* and have the check available at registration.

FOOD:

- Lunch and snacks will be sold for students in the cafeteria.
- A hospitality room will be available for coaches, judges, and bus drivers.

DIRECTIONS:
