



Entry Deadline: Your completed registration is due no later than 2:00 pm, Monday, November 28th. This deadline is critical as we are working hard to fit the entire tournament (all events) at Glacier High School. The web site is TABROOM.COM All that you need to do is set up an account (if you have not used it before) and log in. The process is very user-friendly and will allow you to make any changes to your entry up through 4:00 pm, Thursday, December 8th. Changes to the Registration after the deadline must be made through email (adkinsg@sd5.k12.mt.us) or by calling Greg Adkins at GHS (406) 758-8600 x8668 or cell phone at (406) 309-5065 and will be charged a \$10 fee per change.

ENTRIES: There will not be a limit on entries! Bring everyone, however, the max of 4 in each event will be tabulated for sweepstake points. Events include VPD, NPD, VLD, NLD, LEGI, EXT, IMP, OO, MPA, INF, DI, HI, DUO and POI. Any entries that exceed your max of four on the roster may be entered as a separate JV team on our tabroom, or may simply be determined before the first round, so they do not count in final sweepstake tabulations. SCHEDULE: All events will have the traditional AA schedule (Speech 5 rounds plus Semifinals & Finals, Debate 5 rounds, plus Quarterfinals, Semifinals, and Finals).

FEES: Each participant will be charged a \$5.00 entry fee plus each school will be charged a \$25 team fee.

REGISTRATION: There will be no on-site registration. I will share code #s and tabbing assignments on Thursday. Please check your registration carefully and notify me immediately of any problems/changes.

BUILDINGS: It is our intent to hold all events in Glacier High School. However, if registration numbers max our room space at GHS, we will move Speech events to Flathead High. This decision will be made at 2pm on Monday, November 28th.

CONCESSIONS: Full concessions will be available.

AWARDS: Awards Assembly will be held on Saturday at 6:45 pm in the PERFORMANCE HALL at Glacier High. Awards and certificates will be given to the finalists in every event. Awards will be given to the top three teams in "AA" and in "ABC".
