**Event Rules:** All events will be conducted per the rules in the 2022 – 2023 MHSAA Handbook and will be enforced.

**Debates-** We will be using the September/October topics for all debates.

**LD-** The United States ought to implement a single-payer universal healthcare system.

**Policy-** The United States federal government should substantially increase its security cooperation with the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in one or more of the following areas: artificial intelligence, biotechnology, and cybersecurity.
