## Notes

- "Blast" messages from Tabroom will be sent approximately 15 minutes before the start of each round. Judges and contestants should check their Tabroom dashboards (or online postings) at that time in case the "blast" is delayed.
- There is a 15 minute forfeit rule in effect for all events. After 15 minutes, any late-arriving entry will not be permitted to compete, and any missing judge will be replaced.
- Judges are expected to submit and confirm their ballots (decision/ranks and speaker points)
  within 15 minutes of the end of the round. While judges, especially in Congress, should write the
  bulk of their comments on the electronic ballot during the round, they may add or edit
  comments until the end of the tournament.
