**Policy Debate Topic** Resolved: The United States federal government should substantially increase its security cooperation with the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in one or more of the following areas: artificial intelligence, biotechnology, cybersecurity.

## **Novice Case Areas for Policy**

We will follow the suggested case areas for novice division.

- Artificial Intelligence: Restrict development and/or use of Lethal Autonomous Weapons (LAWs)
- Biotechnology: Ban the use of germline genetic engineering in humans
- Biotechnology: Substantially increase funding for vaccine research
- Cyber: Ban offensive cyber operations

**Lincoln Douglas Debate Topic:** Resolved: The People's Republic of China ought to prioritize environmental protection over economic growth. **We will not be using the Novice LD Topic.** 

**Public Forum Debate Topic** Resolved: The United States' strategy of Great Power Competition produces more benefits than harms.

Parliamentary Debate topics will be a variety of policy and value topics.

### Limits:

Students may NOT double-enter in Debate. While our Tournament will allow double entry in the Individual Event pattern, you may NOT double enter with Extemp.

# Deadlines:

Adds/Drops without penalty will be allowed for all events until Thursday, December 1 at 5 pm.

Judges for all events are due Thursday, December 1 at 5 pm.

Entries without judge coverage will be dropped.
