





Judge Requirements


Here are the judge requirements for the 2023 Cabot Classic -

Forensics - 1 Judge Per 8 Entries Debate and Congress - 1 Judge per 4 Entries

Please note that all coaches MUST be in the judge pool for at least one complete day of the tournament
