**Entry Fees** 

There are no entry fees, but each competitor is required to bring in a holiday-related food item to contribute to our potluck. Please avoid peanuts and tree nuts to be conscious of fellow competitors' allergies.

<u>Judges</u>

- 1 Judge Per 10 IE Entries- 1 Judge Per 4 Debate Entries

Judges must be AT LEAST a sophomore in High school. There will be no fee for every judge you fail to provide however, note that each team abiding by their judge requirements will help the tournament run efficiently and provide an overall better experience. Judges are almost ALWAYS a problem, so we would be greatly appreciative of any "extra" judges you can bring! Please state any times your judges are unavailable on Tabroom with your registration. **Entering in Multiple Events** 

Students may enter multiple events in a given round, but double-entered policies must be followed, and rounds will not be held late to accommodate students with multiple entries. We will follow all NSDA event rules for all forms of debate. 1 preliminary rounds, 1 elimination and 1 final round of debate will be held for all forms of debate.

**Topics** 

Lincoln Douglas Debate will use the Nov/Dec Topic - Resolved: The People's Republic of China ought to prioritize environmental protection over economic growth.

Public Forum Debate will use the Nov/Dec Topic - Resolved: The United States' strategy of Great Power Competition produces more benefits than harms.

Big Questions Debate will use the 2022-2023 Topic - Resolved: Humans are primarily driven by self-interest.
