Milton Academy COVID-19 Policy

Milton's policies continue to be informed by guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE).

We are a mask-friendly environment, which means that individuals who would like to wear a mask are welcome to do so, but we do not require indoor masking unless an individual:

- o has an approved vaccine exemption from the school,
- has been recently exposed to COVID-19, or
- is within 10 days of recovering from a COVID-19 infection.

As per current MMSSL practices, all competitors are permitted to mask even while performing. Judges will be instructed to evaluate each competitor to the best of their ability regardless of the competitor's masked or unmasked status.
