A Bill to Establish a National Standard for the Use of Lethal Force by Law Enforcement

- 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 2. **SECTION 1.** A federal standard for the use of lethal force is hereby established. Law
- a. enforcement personnel may only use lethal force when absolutely necessary to prevent serious
- 4. bodily injury or death, and after exhausting all de-escalation techniques.
- 5. **SECTION 2.** No state, nor jurisdiction within the United States, may grant police officers or
- 6. other law enforcement officials qualified immunity against civil lawsuits.

- A. Lethal force shall be defined as an amount of force that is likely to cause either serious bodily injury or death to another person.
- B. De-escalation techniques shall be defined as actions used by officers, when safe and feasible without compromising law enforcement priorities, that seek to minimize the likelihood of the need to use force during an incident and Increase the likelihood of voluntary compliance.
- SECTION 4. The Department of Justice will be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this legislation.
- 16. **SECTION 5**. All laws in conflict are hereby declared null and void.

A Bill to Establish The Manufacturing Renaissance Corporation

- 5. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED:
- 6. **SECTION 1**. The Manufacturing Renaissance Corporation (MRC) shall be established as a
- 7. government corporation within the United States Department of Commerce.
- 8. **SECTION 2.** The mission of the MRC shall be to
 - 1) Create a national strategic plan for rebuilding domestic manufacturing.
 - 2) Establish, fund, and provide guidance to community-based MRC centers in areas impacted by unemployment due to the loss of manufacturing jobs.
 - 3) Provide advice and support to local manufacturing businesses.
 - 4) Award and administer financial grants to projects on a competitive basis.
 - 5) Make and service loans for new or existing small businesses that seek

 To operate manufacturing business in impacted communities.
 - **SECTION 3**. Within six months of passage, the United States Department of Commerce shall oversee the selection of a board of directors. The board should reflect the diversity of impacted communities. The board of directors will hire the administrative team.
- SECTION 4. Funding for all administrative functions, grants, and loans shall come from an annual appropriation of \$5 billion beginning with 2024 fiscal year (October 1, 2023 to
- September 30, 2024), and continuing for five years through September 2028.
- SECTION 5. Congress must review and reauthorize prior to September 2028, or the MRC will be dissolved, and all programs halted.
- **SECTION 6.** This legislation shall take effect upon passage.
- 25. **SECTION 7.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void

A Bill to Repeal the Debt Ceiling

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED: 1.
- **SECTION 1.** REPEAL OF THE DEBT CEILING 2.
- Sections 3101 (public debt limit) and 3101A (Presidential modification of the debt ceiling) 3.
- of title 31, United States Code, are hereby repealed.
- **SECTION 2**. This law is in effect immediately upon passage. 5.
- **SECTION 3**. All laws in conflict are hereby null and void.

A Resolution to Expel George Santos
