**Entries:** You may enter a maximum of five (5) entries per event except in Multiple Interpretation, where the limit is two (2). If you have more than 5 entries, exceptions may be made after the registration deadline (depending on section sizes). All contestants will be guaranteed three preliminary rounds of speaking with elimination rounds of semifinals and finals to those who qualify.

**Rules:** All events will run under the rules of the Michigan Interscholastic Forensic Association as revised in the Speech Activities Handbook. There are rule changes every year—and the last couple years have seen some significant ones. PLEASE make sure your hired judges are aware of them. A review of the rule changes are available on MIFA's home page: www.theMIFA.org

**Awards:** All contestants in the final round will earn a trophy. There will also be team sweepstakes awards. Contestants with ranks of 3 or better in prelims

and any contestant in semis and finals will earn points for sweepstakes. GRCHS will not be eligible for sweepstakes awards.

**Sweepstakes:** TWO divisions for sweepstakes will be presented. These divisions will be determined by the size of the team registration.

**Judges:** CERTIFIED JUDGES ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. Each school must provide one judge for each five (5) entries or fraction thereof: Duo, Duo Commentary, and Multiple Interpretation count as two (2) entries. If a team is large enough to require over 5 judges, the tournament director will hire non-affiliated judges to meet this requirement with the cost of \$100 being added to the team's registration costs. The necessary number of qualified judges (up to 5 judges) is the responsibility of the team's coach. All judges MUST plan on being available from the beginning of the judges meeting through the end of finals or else the school hiring them assumes an extra fee levy. If a judge misses a scheduled round, then the school will be charged an extra levy. All judges MUST be familiar with MIFA rules before attending the tournament.

# PLEASE SEEK THE VERY BEST IN QUALIFIED PERSONNEL AND MAKE SURE THAT EACH HAS A STOPWATCH AND TIME CARDS.

Judges will also be submitting critiques digitally. We can collect written critiques, but would prefer them submitted online, so bring a laptop if possible!

**Registration:** Registration will be closed at 11:55pm on Tuesday, February 28th with entry fees and judge assignments also being frozen at that time. Even if weather problems arise you must meet your judge commitments as well as pay your initial fees the day of the tournament. The tournament will be filled on a first come, first served basis. However, standbys will be accepted and filled as vacancies occur. A \$10 drop fee will be assessed on Saturday for all drops.
