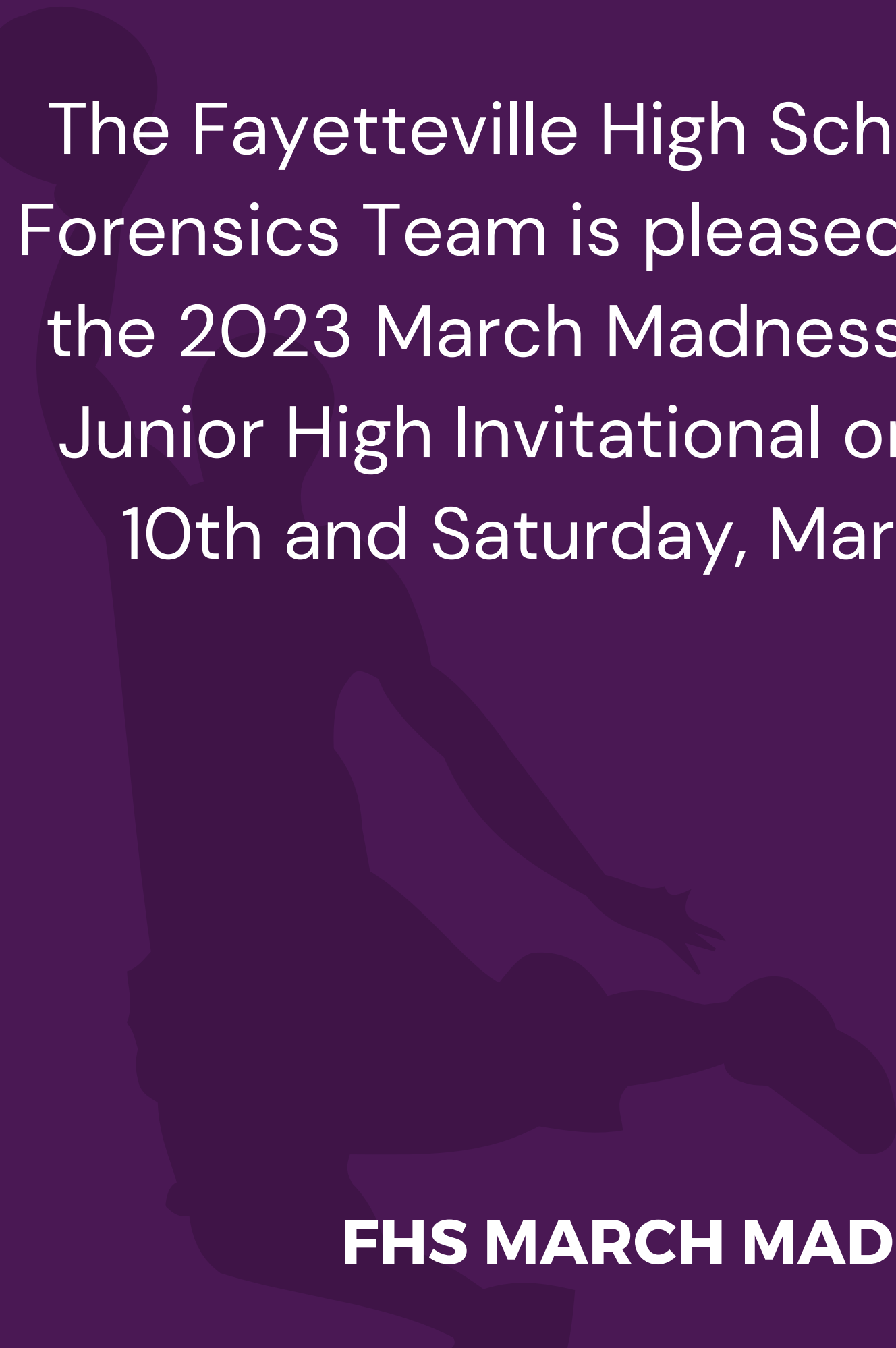

Registration

We will be using Tabroom for registration and tabulation purposes! ALL judges must have online Tabroom accounts. The deadline for entries is FRIDAY, March 3rd at 6:00pm. This is a hard deadline.

Requirements:
