 - **Any entries dropped after 3pm Thursday, Feb 8th will be assessed a \$30 fee**
- We will only be offering Open and Novice divisions for the Traditional (Policy) debate
 - Official rules and times for this debate format can be found on the NEDA website at NEDAdebate.com
 - Depending on the number of teams, Open and Novice teams might face each other in rounds; teams will be separated by division for awards and final rounds
 - There will be final rounds in all divisions as warranted.
- Team awards will be given to the top 4 teams in each division
 - Speaker awards will be given to the top 5 individual debaters in each division
 - Sweepstakes awards will be given to the top 3 schools overall

REGISTRATION:

- Registration will be in Building 14 beginning at 4:00 Friday
- Registration fees:
 - Traditional/Policy **\$70.00** per 2-person team.
 - This includes the \$5 NEDA fee and lunch on Saturday
 - There will be a **\$60.00** 'judge fee' for each uncovered team
 - Each judge provided by a school 'covers' two team entries
 - *Cash payments preferred*

Directions:

FROM THE NORTH:

Exit I-75 at #53A towards Third St – continue on South Robert Drive (a one-way road) that becomes Mead Street. Mead St dead-ends into Longworth/Perry; turn left on Longworth, and the parking lot entrance is immediately on your right

FROM THE SOUTH:

Exit I-75 at #52 and merge onto US-35 East; stay in the right lane and take the Perry Street exit. Keep left at the exit and turn onto Perry Street. Perry dead-ends at Washington; turn left and take the first right onto Longworth. Continue north on Longworth, the parking lot entrance will be on your right after you pass under an overpass.

(If you're plugging this into a GPS, your destination is 'Sinclair Parking Lot K,' in Dayton Ohio 45402 – if you look up directions to Sinclair CC in general, it will direct you several blocks away to a different part of campus)

Parking Lot K is open for visitor parking, no pass or fee is required.
