

A Bill to Control Asian Carp

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Asian Carp shall be controlled by the private individuals. This will be done by exchanging currency for a whole carp. The currency exchange rate will be \$5 per fish.

SECTION 2. Asian Carp includes grass, black, silver and bighead carp.

SECTION 3. The U.S Fish and Wildlife Service will oversee implementation of this bill.

- A. The currency exchange will happen at any U.S Fish and Wildlife Headquarters or SDGFP offices or carp weighing stations set up by the SDGFP.
- B. The GFP and US Fish and Wildlife will also have fishing and hunting goods for sale/trade for carp.
- C. The U.S Fish and Wildlife will dispose of the carp by grinding them to be used for fertilizer or sold for animal feed.
- D. Fishing must be done by bow and arrow, and/or pitchfork, and/or pole/line and/or spear.

SECTION 4. This bill shall take effect on July 1 of 2025..

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
