A Bill to Control Asian Carp

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- **SECTION 1**. Asian Carp shall be controlled by the private individuals. This will be done by exchanging currency for a whole carp. The currency exchange rate will be \$5 per fish.
- **SECTION 2**. Asian Carp includes grass, black, silver and bighead carp.
- **SECTION 3.** The U.S Fish and Wildlife Service will oversee implementation of this bill.
 - A. The currency exchange will happen at any U.S Fish and Wildlife Headquarters or SDGFP offices or carp weighing stations set up by the SDGFP.
 - B. The GFP and US Fish and Wildlife will also have fishing and hunting goods for sale/trade for carp.
 - C. The U.S Fish and Wildlife will dispose of the carp by grinding them to be used for fertilizer or sold for animal feed.
 - D. Fishing must be done by bow and arrow, and/or pitchfork, and/or pole/line and/or spear.
- **SECTION 4.** This bill shall take effect on July 1 of 2025...
- **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
