Coaches/chaperones and/or parents and legal guardians should review the National Season Opener Honor Code, tournament invitation and procedures documents posted on Tabroom, as well as the honor and integrity policies of your own school and program, with each individual representing your squad.

All tournament participants—including competitors, judges, coaches, and observers—must submit a signed Honor Code via Tabroom *in advance of the tournament*.

The National Season Opener Honor Code conveys the significance and importance of competitive integrity to all members of our community, in the interest of maintaining the highest standards of conduct. The National Season Opener Honor Code expects all participants to act with dignity and respect, and refrain from undermining the integrity of speech and debate as an institution. Participants should neither seek, nor encourage others to seek unfair assistance or advantage in competition. All participants and observers are expected to act in good faith and preserve the competitive integrity of the National Season Opener.
