Key Dates:

- Congress Legislation Due: Monday, November 18th at 5:00pm
- New Entries Due: Tuesday, December 10th at 5:00pm
- Judge Entries Due: Wednesday, December 11th at 5:00pm
- All changes after Wednesday December 11th will need to be made by directly contacting the tournament.

Topics & Legislation –

- **Congressional Debate** all legislation submitted through tabroom by November 18th

Each school may submit up to 2 pieces of legislation for debate. All legislation must be submitted as a Word documents. PDFs or will not be accepted.
