The SMART (Systematic Medical AI Reform and Treatment) Act

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2	SECTION 1.	The United States shall invest up to \$4 billion for the training, prototype
3		development, software, and maintenance of healthcare dedicated artificial
4		intelligence.
5	SECTION 2.	A. "Healthcare Artificial intelligence" shall be defined as "The theory and
6		development of computer systems capable of performing tasks in healthcare that
7		typically require human intelligence, such as diagnosing diseases, interpreting
8		medical images, making treatment recommendations, and processing patient data.
9		B. Any business receiving the grant shall receive anywhere from \$5
10		hundred thousand - \$8 million. The amount shall be determined by the
11		committee based on their application.
12	SECTION 3.	The National Artificial Intelligence Initiative, in tandem with the Department of
13		Health and Human services, shall oversee the implementation of this bill. A
14		specialized grant committee shall be created between both administrations in order
15		to assign grant money to developers properly.
16		A. Any U.S. business or healthcare facility may apply though the
17		Department of Health and Human Services to receive a grant to begin
18		research on or participate in healthcare focused Artificial Intelligence
19		B. Funding will be sourced from the Department of Health and Human
20		Services' fund.
21	SECTION 4.	This legislation will take effect on October 1, 2025.
22	SECTION 5.	All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
